BRONCHOSCOPY



A bronchoscopy is a procedure where the patient receives conscious sedation, and a pulmonologist inspects the inside of the airways for diagnostics purposes. Here, samples for diagnosis are also often collected. Contrary to common misconception, there is actually no pain associated with this procedure. The risk of the procedure is fairly minimal. Your pulmonologist will discuss in further detail during your consultation.

- Prior to the procedure please fast from midnight the morning of your procedure.
- Your pulmonologist will advise if any blood thinning medications need to be withheld.
